Level 1 Award in Preparing to Work in Schools (CACHE)

Adult only course. 3hrs per week x 15 weeks. This course is for parents/ carers/ volunteers who are thinking of working in a school setting. This qualification prepares attendees for further learning and training whilst developing an understanding of the teaching and learning environment in a school setting. It covers areas such as how to support the well-being of a child or young person and child and young person development.

Level 1 Award in Supporting a Child's Learning (NOCN)

Adult only course. 2hrs per week x 12 weeks. This Level 1 accredited course is for parents/ carers/ volunteers who would like to gain an understanding of how children learn and develop. It is particularly suitable for parents of pre-school and primary aged children and those who are interested in volunteering or working with children.

Level 2 Award in Supporting a Child's Learning at Home (NOCN)

Adult only course. Minimum 60 hours. E.g. 3 hrs per week. This Level 2 accredited course is for parents/ carers who may be interested in a career of further study in children's care, play work, early years education or similar. Learners will gain knowledge on how to support their child's development such as communication, language and personal, social and emotional skills.

Level 1 Award in Mental Health & Well-being (Ascentis)

Adult only course. 10hrs (2 school days) The Ascentis Level 1 Award in Mental Health and Well-being introduces learners to the terms 'mental health and well-being' and the different types of conditions and the support available.

Volunteer Training Programme

(Non accredited)

Adult only course. 2.5 hours per week for 8 weeks. This course is for those interested in becoming a volunteer or existing volunteers who wish to refresh their skills and training. The course covers topics such as: Introduction to Volunteering, Equality & Diversity, Safe & Sound, Policy & Procedures, Health & Safety and First Aid. On completion of the course we will work with you to try and find a volunteer placement in an appropriate local setting where you can earn Lancashire Time Credit vouchers which can be spent in a variety of locations.
